#### President's Message

January 1, 202 4

Your CNSCA board of directors would like to welcome you to the 2024 season with a bit of an update and the re -introduction of this shoot book is something shooters have been asking for .

Your current board of directors used the 2023 shooting season to transfer and understand roles from the previous board, spend some time going to different shoots across the provinces that they hadn't been to, acquaint themselves with local club needs, (whi ch are different everywhere) and spent considerable time updating the Leaderboard functions to make it more and more useful to club and shooter needs .

Although we didn't manage to get to every dub, collectively, we have learned a lot, and have a better handle on why some things work better in some markets, and why some things don't work so well in others. We've identified some weaknesses and some streng this in our systems and plan to work on exploiting the good parts and re work the sluggish bits. We've got a number of new things we're considering, and we'll share those when we are ready

One of our main focuses, going forward, is to bring more shooters into CNSCA and we are working on some some incentive programs that will be announced in the not -too-distant future.

Part of our growth platform includes bringing Eastern Canada back into the fold. There used to be a strong CNSCA presence out east, and we have been working behind the scenes to re -connect and re-establish that relationship. We hope to see some CNSCA shoot s in the calendar at some point in the 2024 season.

Somewhat tied into that, is the fact that we have been working hard on behalf of CNSCA, to bring the World English Sporting Clays Championship to Canada in 2025. This is a prestigious world class event hosting a possible 400 shooters from all over the worl d that will certainly elevate CNSCA not only on the world stage, but all across Canada. In 2013, this event was held in Galt, Ontario and it looks like it will likely be held there in 2025. This will significantly help strengthen our East/West relationship going forward. Dates and details will be provided when known, but pencil in "sometime in mid -August 2025" for now

In terms of dates for 2024, it's a bit early but many clubs are now entering shoots into the CNSCA calendar online. One main event that we know of now and have been working toward is the 2024 CNSCA Nationals. This year they will be held either side of and through the August long weekend in Vancouver at Vancouver Gun Club. This shoot coincides with Vancouver Gun Club's 100th Anniversary so you can expect this to be a major event. The CNSCA 2024 AGM will also be held at this event, and we're always looking fo r people who are willing to step up and help in your sport

We're hoping to engage/train more clubs in the use of Leaderboard and the CNSCA calendar to publish shoots and track scores for league and CNSCA Registered shoots. Leaderboard has become a valuable tool for those clubs who are using it and uptake is beginn ing to increase. If you want to explore this for your club, contact one of the board members and we'll set you up

Speaking of your CNSCA board, you have 12 people working on your behalf, in various roles in different provinces. If you have any questions you can connect with any one of the directors through the CNSCA website where their contact info is held
